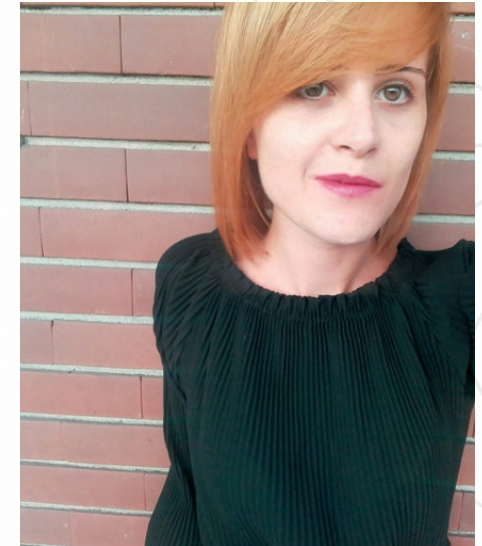
# Who I am, what I have done

- Phd Project: *“Modelling cancer evolution through the development of artificial intelligence-based techniques on temporal and spatial molecular data”*
- Supervisor: **prof. Elisa Ficarra**
- Co-supervisors: **prof. Paolo Garza, prof. Elio Piccolo**
- Short-term goal: to identify **cancer evolutionary metrics** and how they correlate, by means of **statistical methods** and **Bioinformatics** tools and methodologies.
- Long-term goal: to use such non-linear associations to build a **mathematical model** and, through **machine-learning** techniques, categorize cancers based on their evolutionary properties
